hearing and determination of Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction," is extended until August 15, 2010; and it is



FURTHER ORDERED, that if at any time prior to August 15, 2010 Federated confirms receipt of the 2005 Bonds, the parties shall submit a stipulation of dismissal of this action with prejudice to the Court; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, entry of this order is without prejudice to any rights or defenses of the Republic to the entry of any further relief in this action.
