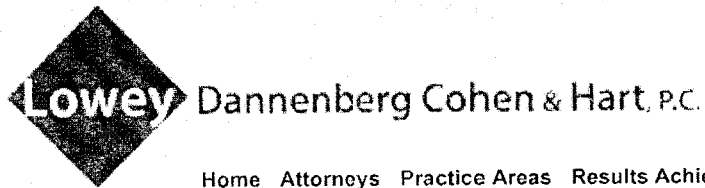
Hart will speak on the topic of amendments to state securities laws to protect pension investments and to give recourse to institutional investors for state securities law violations.
